SALE DATES

- **Friday March 12th Preview Sale 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM (open to sellers only)**
- **Friday March 12th 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM (open to everyone)**
- **Saturday March 13th 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM (open to everyone)**

ACCEPTED ITEMS

- ALL SEASONS, quality, fresh, clean clothes (no buttons missing, no stains, no holes)
- Girl's clothing: infant thru size 12
- Boy's clothing: infant thru size 12
- Maternity Clothes
- Toys (must be in working condition with all pieces attached)
- Books; Videos/DVD's; Video Games; Educational software;
- Shoes (up to ladies/men's size 6);
- Linens; Children's room decor
- Inside and Outside Play equipment
- Furniture
- Baby equipment (strollers, highchairs etc.); or anything else to do with kids!

Please thoroughly check all toys, equipment and electronics before bringing them into the sale and test that they are working properly with all pieces attached. All electronic or battery toys or cars must have functioning batteries and charger.

LIMITS AND EXCLUSIONS

Items not Accepted at sale:

- Stuffed animals (we will accept electronic stuffed animals)
- Underwear, teething toys, or pacifiers
- Boxed cardboard puzzles (Wooden puzzles are great!)
- Car Seats
- Jewelry, not accepted due to potential safety issues with lead.

Infant Clothing Limit: 30 pieces total (not per size) of each gender, size 0-12 months.

There is no limit on all other children's sizes or items.

While we do have numerous security measures to protect your items for sale, we are not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.

PRODUCT SAFETY

- The Consumer Products Safety Commission (CPSC) recently clarified its regulation of the sale of children's products recommended for children age 12 and under. Under these new guidelines, "Sellers of used children's products, such as thrift stores and consignment stores, are not required to certify that those products meet the new lead limits, phthalates standard or new toy standards." However, please be advised it will be your (the consignor's) responsibility to ensure that all items tagged for sale in the TMSA Children's Consignment Sale comply with the CPSC regulations regarding lead content and recalled items.
- All consignors should check the CPSC website (www.cpsc.gov) for information before submitting items for sale to ensure that items offered for sale comply with the new law.
- Items not in compliance may be turned away at check-in or pulled from the sale at the discretion of the TMSA Children's Consignment Sale volunteers.

Seller Instructions

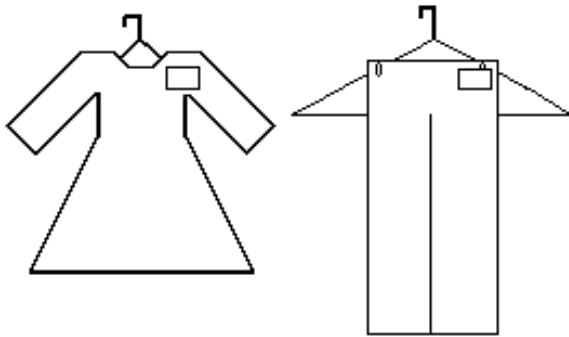
STEP 1 - REGISTER AS A SELLER

- Email Mikey Brayton to receive your seller number: braytont@bellsouth.net
- Please give us a general estimate of the number and type of your items; e.g. 20 size 4 boys items, 10 wooden puzzles, etc.
- Follow tagging instructions below.

STEP 2 - TAGGING/PREPARING INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut a 3x5 index card in half.
- Looking at the tag, safety pin to top center of tag. Size to the right and below the pin.
- Safety Pin (No straight pins or staples) the tags to the garments upper right side and to the tag's upper right corner. See the illustrations below.

Price items in \$1.00 increments only on center or tag. Description of item below price. Seller number center closer to bottom. A large "D" on left bottom corner if you want to donate this item.

- For all other smaller, non-clothing items, please affix the tag to the item by placing clear packing tape over the complete tag. Large taped Ziploc baggies with the tag taped to the front of the tag works well for many small items.
- Shoes can be secured together using shoelaces. Safety pin the tag through the laces. If there are no laces, then intertwine the straps to hold the shoes together and place the safety pin around the strap. **Please DO NOT put shoes into bags.** (Socks, Bibs, Towels, Onesies, infant t-shirts, linens etc. will be placed in bins for display)

STEP 3 - DROP OFF INFORMATION

- Drop off is Thursday, March 11th, 10:00 am to 12:00 pm and 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm at East Point Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall.
- There is a nominal administrative fee of \$5.00 which will be deducted from your seller's check. The administrative fee helps to defray costs associated with registration and seller coordination for the sale.
- All sellers are required to fully assemble all cribs and large play equipment at drop off. Space permitting.
- Please do not sell any of your items in the parking lot to other sellers or volunteers. Thanks!
- Please bring a self addressed stamped envelope to check in. Your check will be mailed to you within 2 weeks.

- Strollers, high chairs and playpens etc. must be thoroughly cleaned and in excellent condition to be accepted.
- Prior to drop off, all of your items must be priced, tagged, and hung correctly. Please sort your clothes by size and gender to save time when dropping off.
- Plan to allow at least 45 minutes to 1 hour to check-in and to hang/display your items.
- All sellers must check in the front desk.
- Sellers will be responsible for hanging your clothes and placing items in the proper place.
- Volunteers will be there to assist you should you need help or guidance.

STEP 4 - SHOP!!! - PREVIEW SALE INFORMATION

- No children under 10....This includes No Infants in front/back carriers (We apologize, however there are no exceptions)
- Only children 10 years and older will be allowed at the preview, and they must stay with their parents at all times
- Most shoppers bring a laundry basket. No wagons, strollers, etc. will be allowed due to lack of space.
- If you have selected items that you no longer want to purchase, we ask that you please re-rack your clothes into the proper size and gender.
- If you want to purchase a large item that can not be moved, please fill out your customer info on the tag and tear off the lower portion of the tag to give to the cashier. **PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE WHOLE TAG** or the item can not be sold. All other large items **should be taken to the "Hold Area"** while you finish shopping.
- All items must be purchased by the seller when placed on Hold. See volunteer for "Hold" ticket
- If anyone sees someone not following our simple shopping guidelines, please notify a volunteer so we can discuss the problem with them. We really want this to be a fun, bargain collecting, shopping experience for everyone!!

STEP 5 – UNSOLD MERCHANDISE PICK UP/CHECK INFORMATION

- Your unsold items that you do not wish to donate will be collected for you to take.
- Any items entered in the sale can only be retrieved at pick up if unsold. Pick up is on Saturday, March 13 from 4:00 pm-7:00 pm.
- All unsold items that are not picked up by 7:00 pm on Saturday, March 13th will be donated to charity.

Seller Payouts & Accounting

- Checks will be mailed to all sellers beginning March 20th.
- Tax receipts for the donation portion will also be mailed beginning March 20th.
- Sellers receive 70% of their sales; all other proceeds from this sale will benefit The Main Street Academy, a Fulton County Charter School.
